**Young Researcher Workshop:** PhD students, post-docs, and assistant professors will present their ongoing research from all areas of Economics, Econometrics, and Economic History and receive feedback from senior researchers. Presentation slots and poster sessions will be available. The best paper contribution will be awarded the **Best Paper Award**. We welcome submissions in the form of (preferably) papers and extended abstracts **until November 8, 2019** via email to [intecon@uni-hohenheim.de](mailto:intecon@uni-hohenheim.de). Accepted papers will be assigned to a discussant (senior researcher). The Young Researcher Workshop is an integral part of the Doctoral Study Program Economics at the University of Hohenheim.

**Winter School: Anthony Strittmatter**, Assistant Professor of Economics at the Swiss Institute for Empirical Economic Research, University of St. Gallen, will give a short course (3 units á 90min) on **Machine Learning**. Each participant of the Winter School is expected to contribute 50 EUR towards expenses. In exceptional cases, the contribution can be waived (upon request). The Winter School contributes to the joint research area **Inequality and Economic Policy Analysis** of the Universities of Tübingen and Hohenheim, the IAW, and HfWU Nuertingen-Geislingen University.

On **Friday**, we will start at 9:00 a.m. with the 3<sup>rd</sup> unit of the Winter School and continue with the Workshop from 10:30 a.m. We plan to close the workshop on Friday after the Best Paper Award ceremony at approx. 4:30 pm.
